FREEDOM GRANTED TO MARIE HARAN, SLAVE
NEGRESS, BY DIRECTORS OF CHARITY HOS-
PITAL.

Petition of directors and spiritual and temporal Administrators of the Charity Hospital for the poor, to allow them to grant the freedom of Marie Haran, wife of free negro, François Tiocon.

Tiocon had made an agreement with the Directors of the Charity Hospital to work without remuneration for the Hospital, for the period of seven years, providing that, at the expiration of that term, his wife, Marie Haran, slave, would be given her freedom. Accordingly, Directors pray Superior Council to grant freedom to said Marie Haran, as Tiocon and said wife served Hospital faithfully for seven years.
